


Granada is a friendly city which is historical yet modern, international but with a strong community feel. Located a short drive for the mountains of Sierra Nevada and less than an hour from the Mediterranean beaches. Granada really does offer you the very best of South of Spain.

UNSURPASSED BEAUTY

The summer school takes place in the heart of Granada. The hotel is situated in the most Emblematic area of the city, called the Albaicín declared in 1994 World Heritage by UNESCO.

Granada is considered one of the most beautiful cities in the world, where numerous artists, writers and travellers from all over the world have been fascinated by its beauty and charm.

At the south of Spain, with an enviable geographical location, the sea and mountains just kilometres away, the capital of western Andalusia has become a cultural reference point in Spain, and very popular with tourists.

ACCOMMODATION

All International Summer Students and the professors will live in several hotels or apartments right in the heart of the city and only few minutes' walk from library facilities, shops, restaurants, theatres, and social areas. Each student will have their own bedroom and bathroom

GREAT CITY FOR SIGHTSEEING

Granada offers many churches, abbeys, monasteries to be visited and of course the Alhambra Palace and the Generalife Gardens from the 11th century and the most visited monument in Spain with more the 3 million visitors a year.

GREAT FOR CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

Students will be able to swim at the Mediterranean beaches in Almuñecar, Salobreña or Nerja. Enjoy the Arabic baths and see a flamenco show in one of the Sacromonte caves. All these activities will be included in the programme fee (see page 9).

GRANADA


Granada is located at the foot of the Sierra Nevada mountains, at the confluence of four rivers, the Beiro, the Darro, the Genil and the Monachil. It sits at an average elevation of 738 m (2,421 ft) above sea level, yet is only one hour by car from the Mediterranean coast, the Costa Tropical.



A vibrant community, Granada has excellent shops, supermarkets, restaurants, programmes of performing arts and other cultural events and entertainment, with the spectacular International Festival of Music and Dance in June.


On 1 December 2014 Granada was officially granted membership of the UNESCO Creative Cities Network (UCCN) in the Literature category.





The Alhambra, a Moorish citadel and palace, is in Granada. It is the most renowned building of the Andalusian Islamic historical legacy with its many cultural attractions that make Granada a popular destination among the touristic cities of Spain.

The Almohad influence on architecture is also preserved in the Granada neighborhood called the Albaicín with its fine examples of Moorish and Morisco construction. Granada is also well-known within Spain for the University of Granada which has about 80,000 students spread over five different campuses in the city.





Centrally Located

Granada is easy to get to. Many cities across the globe fly directly to Granada or Málaga which is one hour away.



GRANADA ON YOUR DOORSTEP

Granada is a city at the south of Spain and has superb links to the rest of the country. Malaga is only 1 hour from Málaga International Airport. Should you want to travel further during your summer in Granada, students can choose from either Granada or Malaga airport to take flights direct, Europe (around two hours to most destinations and a large selections of international destinations).

The recent growth in the number of budget airlines has ensured that it is now affordable to reach Spain with many European destinations, with prices direct to Europe as cheap as 60 Euros return.

Direct flights to Granada from Milan, Paris and London and to Malaga from many European cities such as Krakow, London, Amsterdam, Brussels, Berlin, Frankfurt, Athens, Budapest, Dublin, Rome, Venice, Bologna, Prague, Copenhagen, Oslo, Warsaw, Bratislava, Stockholm, etc.

International Summer School & Conference

IFES International Summer School and Conference is open to graduate, PhD Students as well as postdoctoral researchers from around the world. The broad programme means you can sample student life at the Centre of Granada. IFES Summer School is run by a dedicated team who will help you in anything you need since your arrival.

The programme fee includes all tuition costs, your own private room with bathroom, a comprehensive orientation and social programme, and optional fields trips.

ORIENTATION

At your arrival we provide a comprehensive dossier to all students, including a practical information such as a calendar of the course timetable of your classes and considerable information about the city.

STUDYING ABROAD

Studying abroad is a great experience. During your time here will be many opportunities to explore and experience, Granada and Spanish Culture but students should remember that the primary purpose of the trip is to study. IFES course provides an excellent opportunity to enhance your studies, develop an international experience prospective all while sharing this experience from participants from all over the world.

CLASSES

They are structured in a 5 day block. You can either choose to study for five days or you can also participate and attend a 3-day International Congress at the end of the summer course. You'll have 4 seminars daily as well as have the chance to take part in a range and cultural activities with your fellow students and professors.

MODULE EXCURSIONS

A key feature of the IFES Summer School is the out-of-class learning which will be an integral part of each module. The content will vary but excursions include visits to the tropical beaches in Granada, flamenco show at the Sacromonte caves, Alhambra Palace and Generalife Gardens.

There will also be the possibility to pay just for the courses without the cultural programme as some of you might have already seen the city and its precious monuments.

SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

Social activities and social trips are an important part of the programme. Trips to the coast, visit to the Alhambra, Flameco Show are included in your programe fee if you choose BLOCK 3 (see page 9).

If you choose to attend just the seminars and courses you will have a six day programme of classes from Monday to Friday.

OR

If you choose to attend the International Conference you will have a three day intensive programme.

OR

If you choose to combine the two of them you will have a nine day intensive programme.

You will stay in a hotel with your private room and bathroom right at centre of Granada with all the monuments, shops and restaurants at the tip of your fingers and just ten minutes away from the Alhambra.

When your completed application materials are received, we will review your file and, if you meet the IFES requirements, send you an offer letter for admission with a listing of your pre-approved modules and an Acceptance Form.

We will then ask you to return the Acceptance Booking Form in order to secure your modules and accommodation. Modules will be filled on a first come, first served basis so make sure you apply early.
